
How to access Flash .swf movies

Go to the web site: <u>https://www.adobe.com/support/flashplayer/debug_downloads.html</u> and download the version of 'Flash Player projector content debugger' suitable for your computer and operating system.

This will download a file titled 'flashplayer_32_sa_debug.dmg' in your download folder/directory. Double click on this file and a window will appear on your desktop that looks like,



You can drag the Flash icon to your Applications folder or where-ever you need it. When you launch the Flash Player you will see at the top of the screen 'Flash Player Debugger'. Select the File Menu option to open an .swf file of choice. Once the Flash movie is playing it should work as expected.

In the Windows environment, download the Windows version and launch the exec file. That will unpack the app titled flashplayer_32_sa_debug. Open the app. When open you will see a blank window titled Adobe Flash Player 32 with four menu options. Click on File and select Open... Enter the URL address of the .swf file you would like to enter. Everything should work following that. If not, double check the address you entered.
